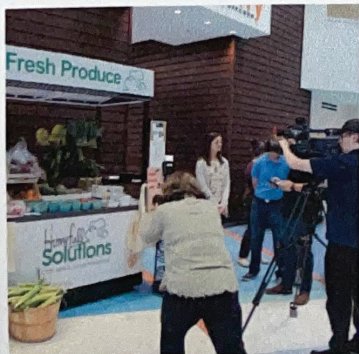

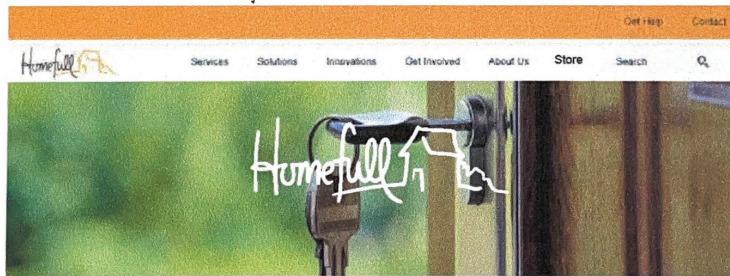

Founded in 1989, Homefull serves over 5,000 men, women and children yearly through its comprehensive continuum of care for the homeless. Our nationally accredited services are designed to be client focused, collaborative and cutting edge. We challenge ourselves to make homelessness rare, short-lived and responsive. Through a group of 100+ dedicated staff members, we have high expectations for ourselves and the people we serve.

Homefull implements programs that truly combat the root issue of homelessness: poverty. As we align our programs to this philosophical shift our mission to work to end homelessness by providing housing, advocacy and education is more appropriate than ever. Housing, Food and Jobs, are now woven into the framework of this organization. From our Gateway Programs, and Housing Programs to our Food Access initiatives we are focused on quality programs and outcomes to address the issues people living in poverty face every day.



Services

Provide services to men, women and families in Ohio and St. Louis. We offer a comprehensive continuum of care and services to persons who are at risk of homelessness, are currently homeless, and have previously been homeless. Case managers work one-on-one with clients with the primary goal of moving them into permanent and appropriate housing as quickly as possible.

Solutions

Social enterprise offers a variety of opportunities for our Ohio clients to obtain job experience, particularly in urban agriculture. Clients can access employment assistance to create a resume, learn interviewing skills, and gain permanent employment. We work on the front lines to combat poverty and hunger issues that many face in the community, and most of the work done with Homefull Solutions
